n Tuesday August 23, 2016, the XI edition of Lost Theory Festival began. The event was held at the Alagón riverbank, near Riomalo de Abajo, village of Las Hurdes (Caminomorisco, Cáceres, Spain), and in lands of the nearby village of Cabaloria (Sotoserrano, Salamanca), now converted into a depopulated since the early 60s by the construction of the reservoir of Gabriel y Galán.

The edition of this traditional event has been gathering every year thousands of people from all over the world and, in Riomalo, the organization talked about a figure of 6,000 attendees, from more than 60 countries.

The preparations have lasted almost a year, but it was worth it, for the experience, the economic impact and because the images of Alagón have been seen around the world.
