and almost they have made we see each other like a bit enemies, when we are neighbors. It is curious that we belong to an association we have created with Portugal to make joint things such as fairs, and we did nothing with Salamanca. I blame the regional administrations.

-How many fairs are organized by Caminomorisco?

-We do three: Beekeepers and Tourism, which is the most important and well known, the Fair of the Snack, on the Saturday of Ester, and a third of Associations, the latter we are trying to consolidate it. We have seven associations: cultural, sports, hiking, older, women...

-What would you ask to your people?

-I would ask optimism to people of Las Hurdes. The region has an important future. What we need is to believe ourselves, to work all of us in first person, in the same direction, and to believe in our possibilities.

It has been a pleasure to talk for a long time with Gervasio. We have learned many things, but we are left with the idea that "Policy" does not have to be so terrible and the politicians are not always a part of this group of persons that we like little ...

The truth is we admire Gervasio's dedication. his closeness, his desire to continue working with enthusiasm for the municipality. We have been witnesses of it with his implication in the performing of the Lost Theory Festival.
